Preparing for Parent Teacher Conferences: **Discussing Early Reading**

or Families To make the most of your time with your child's teacher, here are some tips for before, during and after the conference.

BEFORE the Meeting:

- Reach out to the school to get a copy of the Progress Report to read before the meeting
- Find out who you'll be meeting with and if you'll have a separate meeting with a support person, if your child receives supports
- Prepare and email questions ahead of time ask about going over strategies for individualized support

DURING the Meeting:

- Bring the progress report, highlighted concerns, and questions to the meeting
- Take notes and listen for "key" words (e.g. struggling)- jot down information as you hear it and ask the teacher if there are other opportunities for your child to learn, such as one-to-one instruction
- Share your own insights about your child if you've witnessed your child struggle while reading, mention what you believe has helped

AFTER the Meeting

- Send a follow up thank you email to the teachers -and share what you learned, such as strategies on ways to help your child read
- Talk to your child about what you learned let them know how proud you are and talk about something positive you noticed about them
- Increase your knowledge about interventions reach out to your child's school and ask for information about reading interventions
- Reach out and connect with other parents have conversations with other parents to support one another and share resources
